PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67698 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Iola B. Hickok of 105 Harris Street, The Dalles, Oregon 97058, phone 296-2647, for the use of the waters of Tucker Spring, an unnamed stream, tributaries of Hood River, reservoir being 0.015 cfs from Tucker Spring and 0.01 cfs for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and maintenance of reservoir to be constructed under Application R-67896, Permit R-10034 for recreation; being 0.01 cfs from spring for irrigation, 0.005 cfs from spring for domestic use for one family and that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second

0.025 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring - 460 feet South and 1575 feet East; Unnamed stream - 545 feet South and 1925 feet East, both from the Northwest Corner of Section 21, both being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * from the unnamed stream.
- ** 0.01 cfs from unnamed stream for recreation.

Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM Section 21 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family maintenance of a reservoir for recreation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 21, 1985nd shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87
