PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68105 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Leroy M. Slack of PO Box 43, 82758 Lake Blvd., Westlake, Oregon 97493, phone 997-2092, for the use of the waters of Siltcoos Lake,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 15, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1650 feet South and 530 feet East from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 34, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 19 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 34 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 21, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
