PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68167 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lois M. Brooks of 94787 Adams Road, Gold Beach, Oregon 97444, phone 247-7573, for the use of the waters of a spring,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of one-third acre

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 30, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second 0.005 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 92 feet South and 736.3 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, Township 35 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 14 West, WM Section 31 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.33 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 21, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
