PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68161 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Floyd Boyd of 13710 Lookingglass Road, Winston, Oregon 97496, phone 679-8493, for the use of the waters of South Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 26.9 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 22, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.34 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 300 feet North and 450 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 3, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM	Section 35 SW 1/4 SW 1/4	0.90 acre
Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM	Section 3 NE 1/4 NE 1/4	3.80 acres
	Section 2 NW 1/4 NW 1/4	16.8 acres

	NE 1/4 NW 1/4	1.30 acres
	SE 1/4 NW 1/4	3.30 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 7, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987.
