PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68207** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Ronald K. Baldwin of Cavitt Creek Road, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-0051,** for the use of the waters of **Beaver Creek, a tributary of Cavitt Creek,** for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 22, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.005 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **275 feet North and 1765 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 14, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 27 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 14 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 7, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
