### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63715 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Government, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-7761, for the use of the waters of Sprague River, a tributary of Williamson River, provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed \* for the PURPOSE of road construction, maintenance and dust abatement

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 29, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 400 feet South and 790 feet East from the Quarter Corner of Sections 10 and 11, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
