PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63814 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Government, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-7761, for the use of the waters of Williamson River and an unnamed stream, tributaries of Upper Klamath Lake, provided the total quantity* for the PURPOSE of road construction, maintenance and dust abatement

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 2, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Williamson River) - 300 feet South and 400 feet East from the Quarter Corner of Sections 8 and 9, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 31 South, Range 9 East, WM,; Diversion 2 (Unnamed Stream) - 430 feet South and 1600 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 9, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 32 South, Range 9 East, WM, both in the **
A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* diverted shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per year,
