PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64828 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Government, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-6714, for the use of the waters of Cottonwood Creek, a tributary of Klamath Marsh, for the PURPOSE of livestock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

February 2, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

3984 gallons per day

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 800 feet South and 2380 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Sections 26 (unsurveyed), being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 28 South, Range 6 East, WM; Diversion 2 - 210 feet South and 2600 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 5, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 29 South, Range 7 East, WM, both in the County of Klamath.
