PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64829 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Government, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-6714, for the use of the waters of Bear Creek, a tributary of Klamath Marsh, for the PURPOSE of livestock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 2, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

3984 gallons per day

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 3 - 530 feet South and 470 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Sections 6, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 7 East, WM; Diversion 4 - 220 feet North and 1270 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 11 (unsurveyed), being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 30 South, Range 6 East, WM, both in the County of Klamath.
