PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64830 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Government, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-6714, for the use of the waters of Pothole Creek, a tributary of Klamath Marsh, for the PURPOSE of livestock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 2, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3984 gallons per day

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 5 - 1300 feet North and 1110 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Sections 26 (unsurveyed), being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 26; Diversion 6 - 240 feet North and 1580 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25 (unsurveyed), being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 25; Diversion 7 - 500 feet North and 530 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25 *

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* (unsurveyed), being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 25; all within Township 30 South, Range 6 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.
