PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **67323** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Haken Anderson of Route 1, Harper, Oregon 97906, phone 358-2571,** for the use of two springs and an unnamed stream, being 220 gallons per minute from **Spring 1, 90 gpm from Spring 2, and 101 gpm from the unnamed stream,** for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 39.0 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **November 26, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **411.0 gpm**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Spring 1 - North 12 degrees 25 minutes West 2125 feet, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 24; Spring 2 - North 14 degrees 01 minutes East 2092 feet, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24; Spring 3 - North 46 degrees 50 minutes East 290 feet, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, all in Township 19 South, Range 42 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 21, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**
