PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68205** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **John T. Jones, Jr. and Diane M. Jones of PO Box 268, 2239 Standley Road, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-3985, for the use of an unnamed stream when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the stream to be made up *** for the PURPOSE of **domstic use for one family and irrigation of 5.8 acres, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.073 cfs for irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 19, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.078 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Unnamed Stream - 415 feet South and 2100 feet West from the Southeast Corner of SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 34; Little River - 1380 feet North and 1810 feet West from the Southeast Corner of SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * by appropriation from Little River, a tributary of North Umpqua River,
Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 34 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Dometic use
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 5.8 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 21, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
