PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64134 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

US Forest Service - Deschutes National Forest of 211 NE Revere, Bend, Oregon 97701, phone 382-6922, for the use of the waters of Monty Spring, a tributary of Metolius River, for the PURPOSE of potable water for Monty Campground

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 9, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 600 feet South and 125 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the NW 1/4 of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 11 South, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 11 South, Range 10 East, WM Section 13 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Monty Campground

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 28, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
