PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68221** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife of 506 SW Mill Street, Portland, Oregon 97208, phone 229-5701, for the use of water from an unnamed tributary of Calloway Creek and Adair Pond Reservoir, a tributary of Bowers * for the PURPOSE of maintenance of Adair Pond Reservoir for warm water fish rearing and waterfowl refuge

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 7, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 400 feet North and 1460 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 30, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * Slough/Willamette River, to be constructed under Application R-68220, Permit R-10061,

Township 10 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 30 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Fish rearing pond and SE 1/4 SE 1/4 waterfowl refuge

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 28, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
