PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67589 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Wallowa-Whitman National Forest of PO Box 490, Enterprise, Oregon 97828, phone 426-3151, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of the Snake River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use and irrigation, being 0.007 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.016 cfs for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 20, 1984 for 0.016 cfs and October 13, 1983 for 0.007 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.023 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 200 feet North and 1190 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 3 North, Range 50 East, WM, in the County of Wallowa.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 North, Range 50 East, WM Section 11 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 acre Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 14, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
