PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68227 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Jimmy Evans of 17620 Falls City Road, Dallas, Oregon 97338, phone This permit is issued to 787-3662, for the use of the waters of an unnamed intermittent drainageway and Evans Flashboard Reservoir, a tributary of Little Luckiamute River, to be constructed under* for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 25.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 14, 1984

0.31 cubic foot per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

ne POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 730 feet North and 2400 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 8 South, The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Application R-68226, Permit R-10099,

Township 8 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 23 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 6.7 acres

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 13.8 acres

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 acres

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet from direct flow from storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-10099, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

January 15, 1986 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
