PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68236 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Dale M. and Leona M. Gifford of 2820 Willanch Way, North Bend, Oregon 97459, phone 269-1719, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a

tributary of Willanch Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 3.0 acres, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.038 cfs for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 10, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.043 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 380 feet South and 1300 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 25 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 18 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.0 acres Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

January 15, 1986 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
