PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68233** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Umpqua National Forest of PO Box 1008, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-6601, for the use of the waters of South Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for 6 families and maintenance of a fire protection system, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.01 cfs for maintenance of a fire protection system that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 5, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1230 feet South and 570 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 30 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 33 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for 6 families
 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Maintenance of fire protection system (5 hydrants)
 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Maintenance of fire protection system (7 hydrants)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
