PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68114 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Clifford S. Baker of 5925 Wrentham Market Road, The Dalles, This permit is issued to Oregon 97058, phone 296-9809, for the use of the waters of Fifteenmile Creek, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 54.4 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 3, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.68 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1750 feet North and 170 feet West from the South 1/4 Corner of Section 30, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 1 North, Range 15 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 15 East, WM Section 30 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.2 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 5.2 acres 13.6 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 31.8 acres

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 27, 1986 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
