PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68125 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Elmer R. Sutton of Route 2, 80x 2, Days Creek, Oregon 97429, phone 825-3482, for the use of the waters of Porter Creek and five unnamed reservoirs, tributaries of Umpqua River, to be contructed under Application R-68193,* for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families and irrigation of 42.9 acres, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from Porter Creek for domestic use and 0.45 cfs from Porter Creek and five reservoir for irrigation that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 20, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.46 CUDIC foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Stream 1 - 70 feet South and 1250 feet West; Stream 2 - 450 feet South and 1100 feet West; Stream 3 - 620 feet South and 900 feet West; Stream 4 - 860 feet South and 600 feet West; Stream 5 - 1200 feet South and 200 feet West, all from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 30 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 10 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.4 acres Domestic use

for two families

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.0 acres

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 27.0 acres Domestic use

for one family

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 7.0 acres

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.5 acre

Section 11 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 acres

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet from direct flow and storage from five reservoirs to be constructed under Permit R-10325.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 27, 1986 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87
