PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68170 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mary E. Brei of 5441 Hubbard Creek Route, Umpqua, Oregon 97486, phone 459-9645, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Hubbard Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 0.5 acre

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 5, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 775 feet North and 905 feet West, from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 20, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20; Diversion 2 - 1100 feet North and 1390 feet West, from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 20, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, both within Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 20 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family
0.5 acre irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to $\frac{1}{80}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre, provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 27, 1986 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
