PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68255** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Barbara A. Shelbourn** of **29185 Salmon River Highway, Grand Ronde, Oregon 97347, phone 879-5390**, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of **Rogue River**, for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **January 15, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **925 feet North and 1390 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 6 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 8 West, WM Section 11 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 27, 1986** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1986**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1987**.
