PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66985 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bureau of Land Management of 74 South Alvord Avenue, Burns, Oregon 97720, phone 573-5241, for the use of the waters of Branson Creek (4839) Spring, a tributary of Branson Creek, for the PURPOSE of livestock and wildlife

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

September 30, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **2.0** gallons per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 900 feet South and 1450 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 31, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 10 South, Range 26 East, WM Section 31 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Livestock and wildlife

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 4, 1986 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
