PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 56590 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-6714, for the use of the waters of either or both of two unnamed springs, tributaries of Williamson River, for the PURPOSE of livestock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 22, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs from each spring

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: A - 1000 feet North and 1200 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 27, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27; B + 1600 feet North and 200 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 26, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, both in Township 32 South, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South, Range 10 East, WM Section 27 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Livestock Section 26 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Livestock

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 11, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.


