## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68239 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

T. Kenneth Smith - Raleigh P. Wirth of HC 52 Box 318, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 267-6155, for the use of the waters of an unnamed creek, a tributary of Coos River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 19, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 180 feet South and 178 feet East from the Southeast Corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 31, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 25 South, Range 11 West, WM Section 31 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for three families

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 12, 1986 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
