PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67695 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William E. and Mildred Tucker of Box 24 Quines Creek Road, Azalea, Oregon 97410, phone 837-3335, for the use of the waters of Quines Creek, a tributary of Cow Creek, and 6.2 acre-feet from Tucker Reservoir, to be constructed under * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 6.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 20.4 acres, being 0.09 cfs for irrigation from Quines Creek and 0.2 acre-foot stored water from Tucker Reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-10447 for supplemental irrigation that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 18, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1-1000 feet North and 680 feet East, Diversion 2-1240 feet North and 500 feet East, both from the Southwest Corner of Section 26, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM Sections 26 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.9 acres Supplemental SW 1/4 SW 1/4 6.6 acres 17.5 acres Supplemental

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
