PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68265 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George M. Heath of Route 1, Box 272H, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, phone 839-4341, for the use of the waters of South Umpqua River, a tributary of the Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 10.0 acres and domestic use,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 25, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second, being 0.125 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 790 feet South and 710 feet West from the North 1/4 of Section 20, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South, Range 5 West, WM Sections 20 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 8.50 acres Irrigation
NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.70 acre Irrigation
Section 17 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.80 acre Irrigation
and domestic

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1986, and reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.
