## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68267 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Benjamin M. Synon of 5020 Mill Creek Road, The Dalles, Oregon 97058, phone 296-4927, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of Mill Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 30, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2100 feet North and 300 feet East from the Southwest Corner of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 7, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 13 East, WM Section 7 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1986 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.
