PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68277 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bernard L. and Helena M. Muehlenkamp of 1114 Stayton Place, Stayton, Oregon 97383, phone 769-7075, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Hess Creek, for the PURPOSE of stockwater

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 15, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1329 feet South and 1056.7 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 28, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 28 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Stockwater

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1986 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.
