PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68284 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Glenn A. Walters of 2813 Pacific Avenue, Suite C, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 359-4453, for the use of the waters of an unnamed intermittent stream, a tributary of Dairy Creek and reservoir, constructed under * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 32.2 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 21, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed U.4 Cf

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1450 feet North and 2200 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 2, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM Section 2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 12.8 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 13.8 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.2 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.5 acre NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.9 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet from direct flow and reservoir constructed under Permit R-7814, provided further water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for stored water, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.ary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
