## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65222** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Sanitiam Water Control District by Dan J. Wilson, Manager of 11371 Dieckman Lane, SE, Aumsville, Oregon 97325, phone 769-2669, for the use of the waters of the North Sanitiam River, a tributary of Santiam River,** for the PURPOSE of **development of 310 theoretical horsepower at the Water Street Hydroelectric Project**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 23, 1983 for 165.0 cfs and August 20, 1984 for 20.0 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **185.0 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1800 feet South and 2830 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Marion.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 9 South, Range 1 West, WM Section 10 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Hydroelectric production power**

The right granted herein is expressly made inferior in right and subsequent in time to any appropriation of water from this source which may hereafter be made for domestic, municipal, irrigation for any other beneficial consumptive use, or for storage for such purposes, provided further that the project shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer, provided further that the permittee shall comply with the provisions of the order of the Water Policy Review Board dated February 26, 1985, and by reference herein made part of this permit, provided further that the permittee must remain qualified as a municipal corporation and that failure to remain qualified or assignment of the permit to a non-municipal corporation will result in cancellation of this permit.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **April 25, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**.
