PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68280 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Edwin Billings of 04293 Billings Road, Agness, Oregon 97406, phone 247-6433, for the use of the waters of Foster Creek and a spring; water to be diverted from Foster Creek when of adequate quality and to be diverted from the * for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 19, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring - 1380 feet South and 280 feet West; Foster Creek - 1410 feet South and 100 feet West, both from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 18, both being within SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 34 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* spring when the waters of Foster Creek are turbid or of poor quality provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

Township 34 South, Range 11 West, WM Section 18 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 13, 1986 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
