This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68306 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lenora Helias of 660 Jesse Lane, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-3805, for the use of the waters of Tucker Creek, a tributary of South Deer Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use

domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

March 21, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.005 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 220 feet South and 80 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12, being within SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12, Township 28 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 12 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 13, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87
