PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68315 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 68315 limitations and conditions:

Helen and Martin Carter and Donna and Gerald Carter of John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-2756, for the use of the waters of John Day River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 12.8 acres and supplemental irrigation of 29.2 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 3, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.05 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2050 feet North and 2000 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, being within NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 13 South, Range 32 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South, Range 32 East, WM Section 21 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 8.8 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 7.6 acres Supplemental Section 22 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 4.0 acres Primary SW 1/4 NW 1/4 19.3 acres Supplemental NW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.3 acres Supplemental

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 13, 1986 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
