PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **66610** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **United States of America, Siskiyou National Forest of 200 NE Greenfield Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-5301, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of Winchuck River,** for the PURPOSE of **potable water and flush toilets for public campground at Winchuck Campground**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 22, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.02 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **924 feet South and 858 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 41 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Curry.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 41 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 10 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Public campground

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **May 20, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**. **Extended to October 1, 1990**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**. **Extended to October 1, 1990**
