PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68247** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Peter W. Schoeningh, Jr. of Route 1, Box 116, Haines, Oregon 97833, phone 856-3488,** for the use of the waters of North Powder River when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the North Powder River to made up by* for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 51.0 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **December 28, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.28 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 2760 feet South and 2380 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 32, Township 6 South, Range 38 East, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5; Diversion 2 - 920 feet South and 1880 feet West from the Southwest Corner of Section 6, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, being within th NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, both being within Township 7 South, Range 38 East, WM, in the ****

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * appropriation from Hot Spring Creek, AKA Warm Springs Creek, a tributary of Powder River,
- ** County of Baker.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **May 20, 1986** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
