## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 58287 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 68287 limitations and conditions:

for the PURPOSE of Stock water

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

February 27, 1985

0.005 cubic foot per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

680 feet North and 1160 feet West from the Southeast The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Corner of Section 27, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 5 North, Range 30 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 North, Range 30 East, WM Section 27 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Stockwater

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 20, 1986 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
