## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68322 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Joseph E. Lalack of PO Box 314, Mill City, Oregon 97360, phone 897-2178, for the use of the waters of North Santiam River, a tributary of Willamette River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 0.5 acre

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 10, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1433 feet North and 804 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 30, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 9 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Linn.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 3 East, WM Section 30 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.1 acre Irrigation SE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.4 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 20, 1986, and reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
