PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68129 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Rolland H. and Mae S. Carr of PO Box 1093, Cave Junction, This permit is issued to 97523, for the use of the waters of Illinois River, a tributary of Roque Oregon

irrigation of 18.0 acres for the PURPOSE of

July 24, 1984 that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

0.23 cubic foot and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 428 feet North and 75 feet East; Diversion 2 - 50 feet North and 25 feet East, both from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 16, being within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM Section 16 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 18.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/50 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. During the period July 1 to October 1 of each year, irrigation use is limited to a non-commercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area.
