PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68283 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dale Wertz of 7105 Red Prairie Road, Sheridan, Oregon 97378, phone 843-2816, for the use of the waters of Wertz Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-68282, Permit R-10480, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 3.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 22, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.2 acre-feet stored water only

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1200 feet South and 50 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Jacob Cox DLC 42, being within NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 22 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.0 acres Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-10480.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
