PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68286 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Silver Lake Irrigation District, c/o Lawrence Iverson of Silver Lake, Oregon 97638, phone 576-2217, for the use of the waters of Silver Creek, a tributary of Silver Lake, for the PURPOSE of stock watering during the period October 1 through May 15 of each year

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 27, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 100 feet South and 1300 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 5, being within NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 29 South, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

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The appropriation shall be limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed one-tenth of one cubic foot per second for each one-thousand head of stock, provided at times when no water is being diverted from Silver Creek for irrigation, such quantity of water not to exceed 1.0 cfs may be diverted under the supervision of the Watermaster as is necessary for proper distribution throughout the system, provided that the ditches are regularly maintained in good condition and that all water users shall so far as practicable provide stock watering holes or ponds into which stock water may be diverted periodically.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1986 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88 .
