PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68245** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Fred E. Thorburn of PO Box 908, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 837-8041, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Elgarose Creek, when available with any deficiency in supply from the stream to be made up * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 10.5 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 26, 1984 for use from pond and reservoir; April 18, 1985 for use from the unnamed stream

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: A - 375 feet South and 650 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 33, being within NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33; B - 130 feet North from the Southwest Corner of Section 27, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, both within Township 26 South, Range 7 West, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* by appropriation from a natural pond and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-68292, Permit R-10481,

Township 26 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 27 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.5 acre Irrigation
Section 34 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 10.0 acres Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 7, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
