PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68332 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Karen Fleck Harding of PO Box 63, Philomath, Oregon 97370, phone 757-6868, for the use of the waters of Mary's River, a tributary of Willamette River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 15.06 acres and doemstic use for one family, being 0.187 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 22, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.192 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 15 feet North and 1910 feet East from the Northeast Corner of DLC 61, being within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 11 South, Range 6 West, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 11 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 27 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 7.42 acres
Section 26 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.64 acres
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Doesstic use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before 3.1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986. Extended to October 1, 1990.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88. Extended to October 1, 1990
