PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68301 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dorothy Jean Josellis of Star Route 2, Box 207, Tidewater, Oregon 97390, phone 528-7183, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Five Rivers River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

March 18, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 200 feet South and 1550.51 feet East from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 1, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Lincoln.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 15 South, Range 10 West, WM Section 1 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before 311y 2, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
