PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 58351 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Budd L. Shaffer of 8105 Red Prairie Road, Sheridan, Oregon 97378, phone 843-3188, for the use of the waters of an unnamed drainage way and Mohney Reservoir, a tributary of South Yamhill River, to be constructed under * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 9.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 28.7 acres from the unnamed drainage way, Mohney Reservoir, and Mohney Reservoir Enlargment for irrigation of 3.0 acres and use of stored water only from Mohney Reservoir ** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 15, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.112 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2230 feet South and 2130 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

** Enlargment for supplemental irrigation of 28.7 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-10506.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 2, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
