## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68355 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Frank V. Hurd and/or Cheri L. Hurd of Box 35, North Rueben Road, Glendale, Oregon 97442, phone 832-2977, for the use of the waters of Cow Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 13.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 20, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 780 feet North and 480 feet East, from the Southwest Corner of Section 36, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36; Diversion 2 - 600 feet North and 1350 feet East, from the Southwest Corner of Section 36, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, both within Township 32 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 36 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 6.0 acres Irrigation  
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 7.0 acres Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

During the period July 15 through September 20 of each year, use of water for irrigation shall be limited to a non-commercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 2, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1988.
