PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68377** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Francis P. Schomus of 1895 Corina Drive, SE, Salem, Oregon 97302, phone 364-6637,** for the use of the waters of **Pringle Creek,**

for the PURPOSE of **heat pump heating and cooling a residence**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 7, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **6.0 gallons per minute**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **770 feet South and 280 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 2, being within NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 8 South, Range 3 West, in the County of Marion.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 2 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Heat Pump

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 29, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
