PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68396 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James A. and Colleen Cooper of 291 SE Henry Street, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 673-4359, for the use of the waters of Deer Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 0.5 acre

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 17, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1085 feet South and 1060 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 27 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 19 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.5 acre Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to the irrigation of a non-commercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 29, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
