PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68203 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ronald A. Walch of 10399 S. Fork Little Butte Creek Road, Eagle Point, Oregon 97524, phone 826-5237, for the use of the waters of two springs, being 4.3 gallons per minute from Spring 1 and 4.4 gpm from Spring 2, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 0.75 acre and domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden, being 2.1 gpm from each spring for irrigation and 2.2 gpm from Spring 1 and 2.3 gpm from * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 18, 1984 for domestic use and December 28, 1984 for irrigation use

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 8.7 gpm

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1-840 feet North and 460 feet East; Diversion 2-900 feet North and 520 feet East, both from the Southwest Corner of Section 7, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 37 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 9, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987. Extended to October 1, 1989

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989 Extended to October 1, 1989
