PERMIT TO TAKE WATER FROM

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68297 and do hereby **GRANT** **THE PUBLIC WATERS** INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY ACT, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Shauna M. Magnusen of 5361 Production Drive, Huntington Beach, California 92649, phone (714)891-2411, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and Applegate Reservoir constructed under Application R-57600, Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 5.0 acres from river and reservoir and supplemental irrigation of 9.0 acres from reservoir

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 13, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.175 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1020 feet North and 554 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 33, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson. Applegate Reservoir Dam is located within S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under R 7810 and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 5-07-10-W0545 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director,

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 9, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88 .
